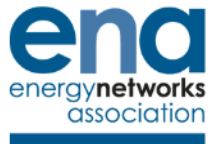
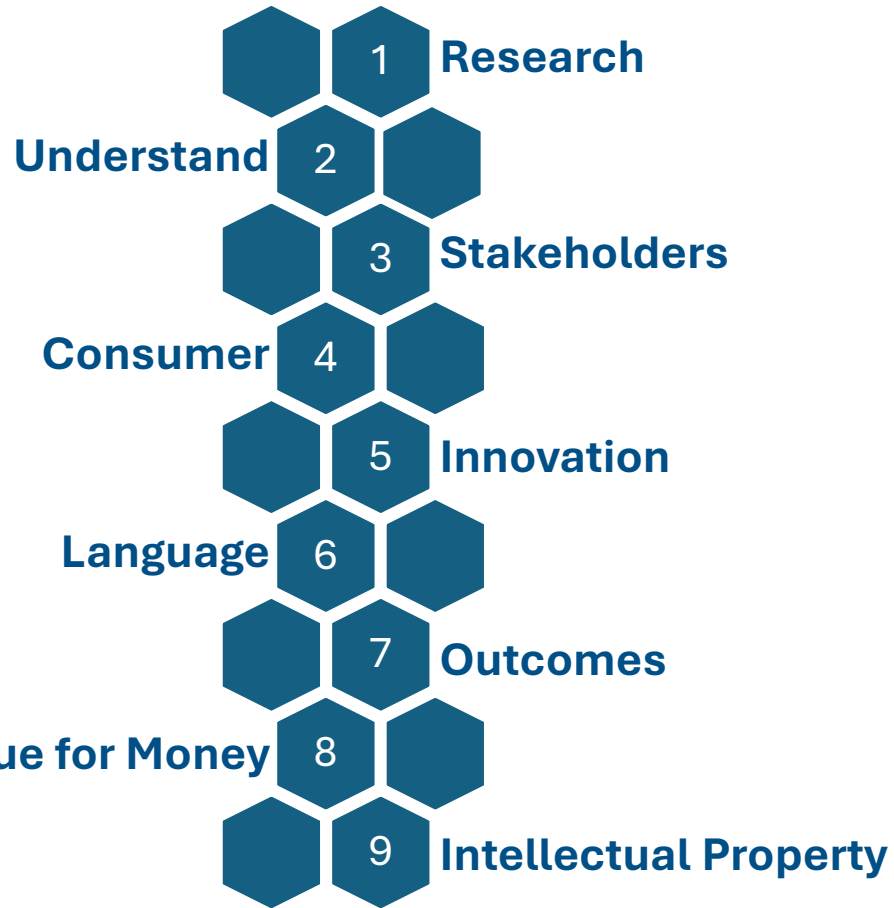

Research

Understand

- Is the nature/context of what's being asked in the problem statements understood?
- Are proposals a solution to the problem raised?

- Has an independent person reviewed draft proposal to “sense check”?

Top tips for success



Stakeholders

- An electricity network stakeholder is any individual, group or organisation that has an interest in the future of our energy system, this can include
 - Government and regulatory bodies, non-energy utilities and wider industry, innovators, research & academia, industry associations, consumers, communities, consultants, technology and equipment providers,
- Are they identified in the proposal?
- How will they be involved/communicated with/collaborated with?

Top tips for success



Consumer

- Are benefits to the consumer clearly highlighted?
- This is important for all innovation funding evaluations/submissions
- It could be by reducing costs, improving efficiency, and also societal benefits
- Have any potential impacts on vulnerable consumers been considered?

Top tips for success



Innovation

- Do the proposed solution(s) involve network innovation?
- Does it address a Networks “pain point”?
- Is it clear what the implementation of new processes, products, services and methods of delivery are which result in significant improvements in outcomes, efficiency, effectiveness or quality?

Top tips for success



Language

- Is the language used concise and focused?
- Don't assume to be the subject matter expert as you don't know who will be reviewing the proposal

Top tips for success



Outcomes

- Are the expected deliverables, learnings, barriers and risks identified?
- Why/how are the expected deliverables achievable?

Top tips for success



Value for money

- How will your solution benefit the network operator and energy consumers?
- Does the project plan aligns with budget requested?

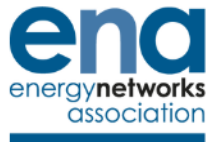
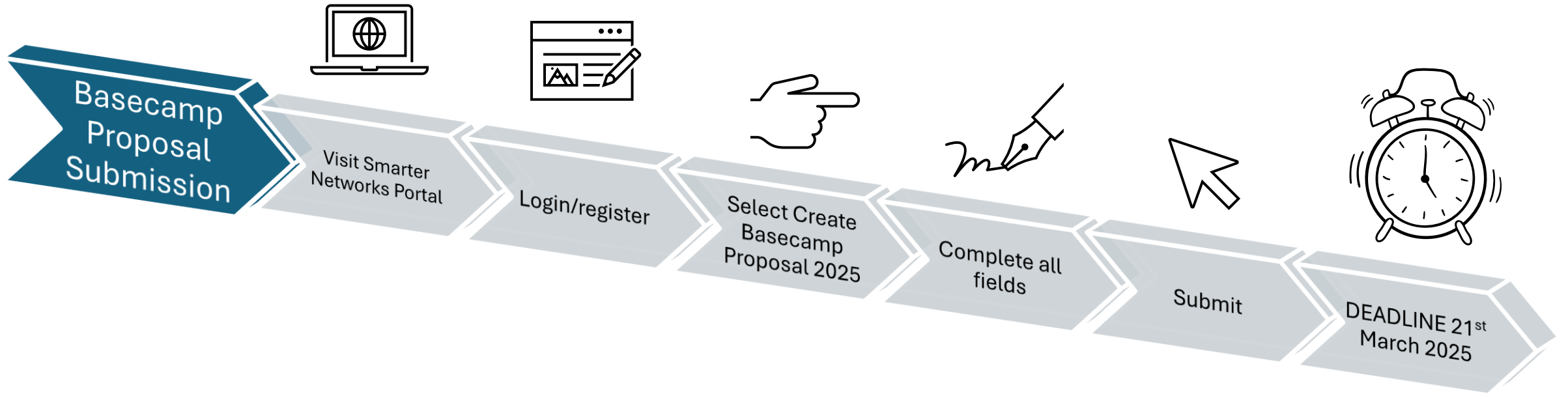
Top tips for success



Intellectual Property

- If relevant bring to the project to aid solutions
- Are there cross overs from other industries/applications that bring value?

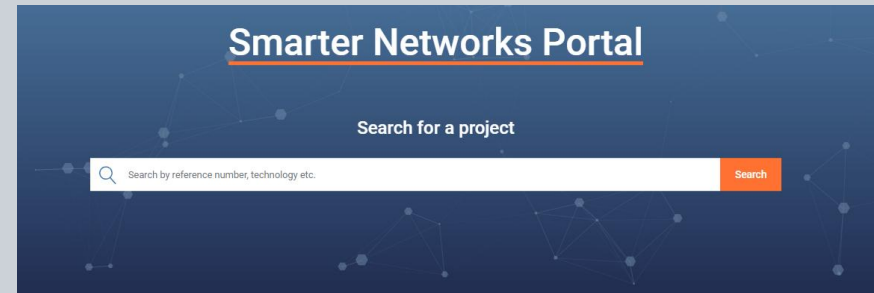
