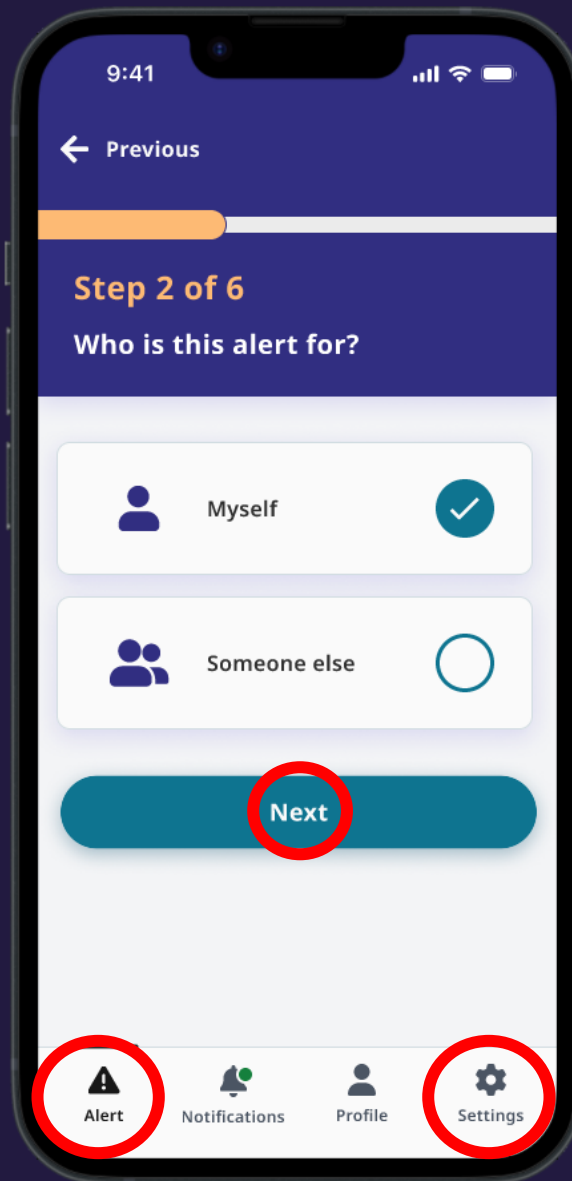




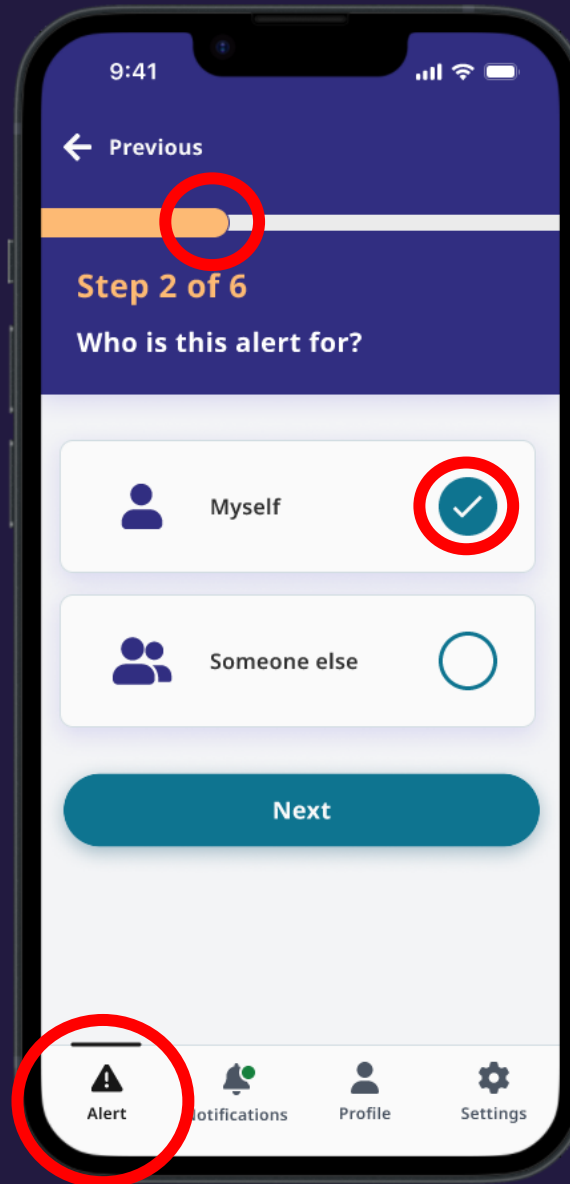
Limit white on the screen, opting for grey to prevent overstimulation



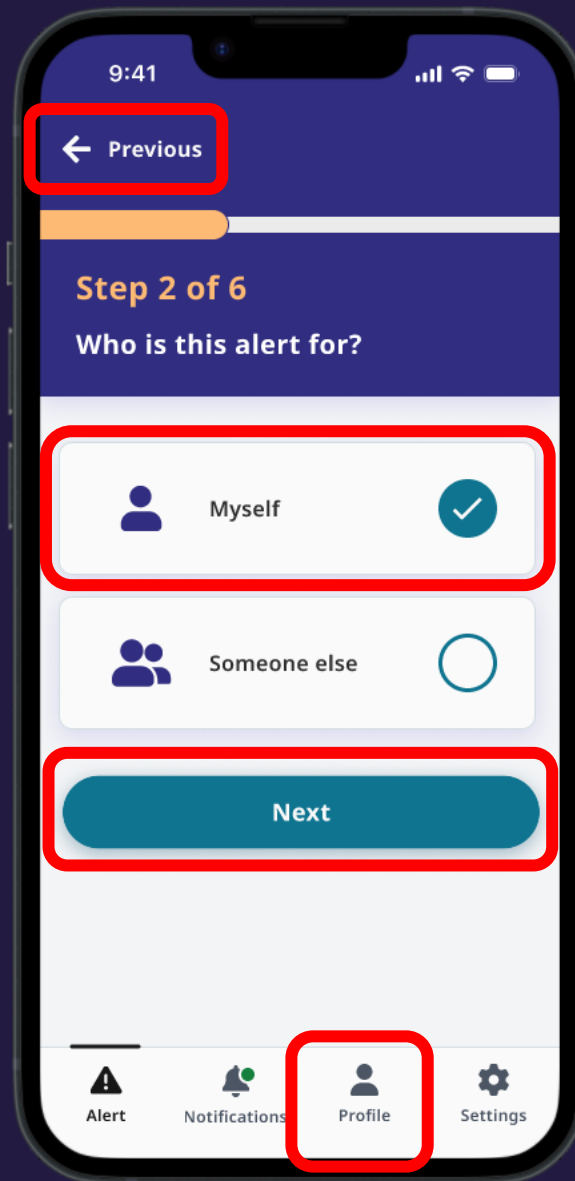
Use icons wherever possible to communicate to people whose first language is not spoken (e.g., BSL)

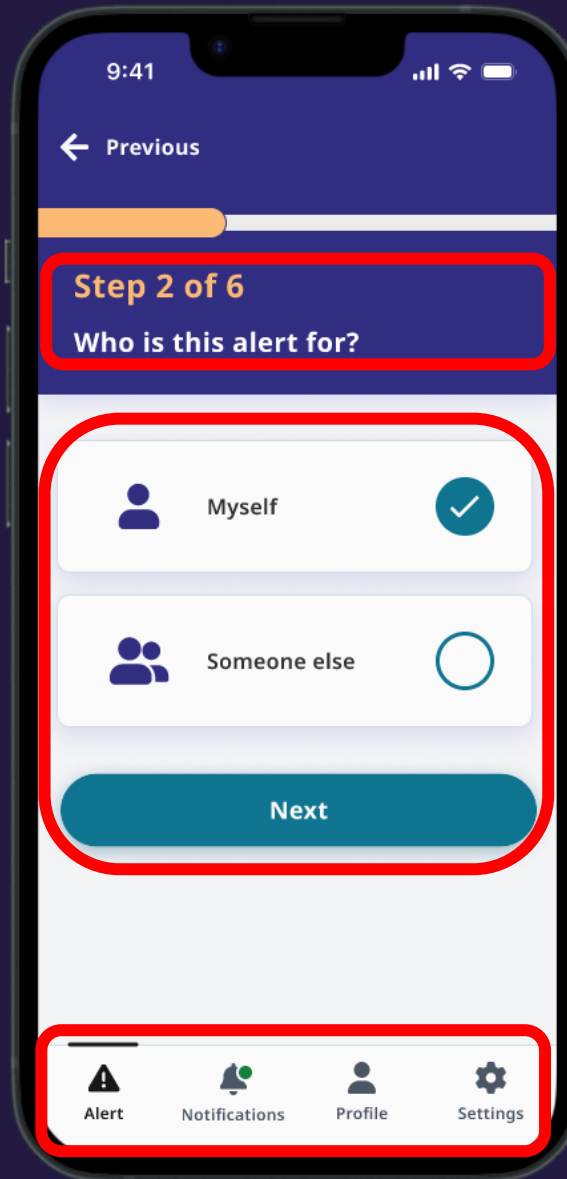
