

Show and Tell guidance

What is a 'Show and Tell' presentation and why is it required?

As stated in the SIF Governance Document, the Funding Party must present findings at a public show and tell webinar. This provides the Funding Party with an opportunity to take questions from interested stakeholders and Expert Assessors.

The presentation should last no longer than 15 minutes, followed by a 15 minute Q&A session. Each webinar will be recorded and saved on a sharing platform.

The Show and Tell presentations will form part of the assessment of the Alpha competition, along with the responses to the Alpha application questions, the End of Phase Reports and the interviews.

Show and Tell guidance

Below is a guide on the content to include in your Show and Tell

- 1. Describe the problem your project is seeking to address (1 min)**
- 2. Retrospective review (11 mins)**
 - general project overview/summary
 - opportunities you have identified for addressing the problem
 - the user needs you have developed and understood in relation to the problem
 - what activities have you done / how have you approached the problem (ways of working etc)
 - potential benefits
- 3. Look ahead (3 mins)**
 - how have your findings informed future activities
 - what next?
